FEBRUARY 18: *Marie Heurtin* (*Marie's Story*, dir. J.-P. Améris) “[A] miraculous tale, much like Helen Keller’s,” “beautiful in its dappled-sunshine light, and powerful in the story of transformation that it tells” (*The Seattle Times*). “An account of faith as well as knowledge, the movie recalls the work of such transcendental French filmmakers as [...] Robert Bresson” (*NPR*).

MARCH 18: *La famille Bélier* (*The Bélier Family*, dir. É. Lartigau) “A captivating new star is born in *The Bélier Family*, Eric Lartigau’s fabulous, heart-felt comedy hit about a young girl whose close bond to her hearing-impaired family is challenged by the discovery of an extraordinary talent for music” (*New York Times*).



APRIL 15: *Sur mes lèvres* (*Read My Lips*, dir. J. Audiard) “[C]ombines a workplace romance with a neo-noir thriller cent[er]ed on a deaf femme fatale” (*British Film Institute*). “[A] splendidly amoral thriller of passion and double-crossing” set “in a dingy, corrupt Paris far removed from *Amélie*’s City of Light” (*The Guardian*).
