

Japanese course content

JPN 111: Yookoso! Invitation to Contemporary Japanese with online learning center Workbook/Lab Manual to accompany Yookoso!

kana syllabary (both *hiragana* and *katakana*), 24 basic *kanji*, sentence structure, basic sentence particles (including possessive particle), self-introduction, etc.

JPN 112: Yookoso! Invitation to Contemporary Japanese with online learning center Workbook/Lab Manual to accompany Yookoso!

verb conjugations in the *desu/masu* style and the plain style, use of location and position words, adjectives and adverbs, expressing likes and dislikes, making suggestions, giving reasons, comparatives and superlatives, *-te* form of verbs and adjectives, talking about the weather, *ko-so-a-dō* demonstratives and pronouns, approximately 75 more *kanji*

JPN 115: Yookoso! Continuing with Contemporary Japanese, Workbook/Lab Manual to accompany Yookoso!

Expressions with interrogatives, nominalization of verbs and adjectives (with *no* and *koto*), potential forms of verbs, relative clauses, expressing desire (*tai/tagaru* forms of verbs), volitional forms of verbs, the *taru* conditional, auxiliary verbs (*iru*, *miru*, *shimau*, etc.), temporal clauses (with *toki*), reporting hearsay (with *sō da*), saying whether something is difficult or easy (*yasui/nikui*)

JPN 116: Yookoso! Continuing with Contemporary Japanese, Workbook/Lab Manual to accompany Yookoso!

The *to* conditional, command forms, chronological order (*mae/ato/-te kara*), admonishment and prohibition (*-te wa ikenai*), obligation (*-nakereba naranai*), the *-tari* conjugation, verbs of giving and receiving, giving advice (*hōga ii*), giving permission (*-te mo ii*), transitive and intransitive verb pairs, completed actions (with *tokoro* or *bakari*)

Passives, causatives, the third conditional form, and honorifics are not introduced until **JPN 231
