March 30, 2017 - One 3 hour class at ISU
- Accommodation: Hotel, 2 meals/ day included + some dinners
- Spanish minors encouraged to apply
- 4 hours of intensive Spanish classes every day (5 days)
- Cultural/language activities in the afternoon (2 per day in the evenings)
- Excursions on the weekends to Gamboa, Embera Village, Monkey Island , and Isla Grande.
- Volunteer activity at Aldeas SOS

Prerequisites:

- Must have successfully completed SPA 116 with a C or higher prior to program start or permission from instructor.
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Good academic and disciplinary standing
