- Open to all majors and minors
 - Preference given to business students, if limited spots are available
- Undergraduate & Graduate students
- ISU cumulative GPA of a 2.5 (undergrad) or 3.0 (grad)
- Completion of 24 credit hours at ISU or other college/university prior to program departure

The Location:

- ITESM is located in **Querétaro**, 2 hours North from Mexico City and a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- It is one of the safest and most culturally and technologically advanced cities in Latin America

Housing:
